



Scholarship Application

The **Antoinette C. Hodes Scholarship** is awarded to a student who is enrolled in a Kentucky college, has performed voluntary service in a mental health setting, and is preparing for a mental health field.

The **Evan and Katherine Harrod Scholarship** was established in memory of the parents of late board member Evan "Pete" Harrod and is given to a student who qualifies for a Hodes scholarship and is from a **rural** area.

Each award is for \$1000 and is given at the association's annual meeting in October.

Instructions

Award Criteria:

- College or graduate student enrolled in a Kentucky public or private college or university
- Has performed voluntary service in a mental health environment
- Planning or engaged in a course of study in a mental health field

Process:

- Application with all required attachments must be postmarked by September 1.
- Attach two letters of recommendation, one from a college adviser or instructor in the mental health field, the other from the mental health agency where the applicant volunteered.
- Attach a copy of the applicant's college transcript
- Mail as a packet to: MHA-Kentucky, 120 Sears Ave. Ste. 213, Louisville, KY 40207
- Applications must be postmarked by September 1.
- MHA-Kentucky will contact awardees by October 1.
